Detailed Procedure of the

Third Convocation

Thursday, 24th November, 2022 at 3:00 PM

University Library Auditorium

Palamuru University Campus, Mahabubnagar - 509 001.

DRESS: The Vice-Chancellor, the Members of the Executive Council, the Deans of the Faculties, the Registrar and all the candidates shall wear White Dress, with badges.

All the candidates and invitees shall be in their seats by 2:30 pm.

ASSEMBLAGE OF EC MEMBERS & DEANS

The Members of the Executive Council, and Deans of all the Faculties shall assemble at 2:45 PM in the left side verandah of the University Library Auditorium.

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL FOR SUPPLECATION OF GRACE

A special meeting of the Executive Council will be held at 2.50 PM at the left side verandah of the Auditorium.

Prof. A. Rama Krishna, Dean, Faculty of Education will supplicate the grace of the Executive Council for admission to Degrees, Diplomas and Doctor of Philosophy in the Faculties of Arts & Social Sciences, Science, Commerce & Business Management, Education, and Pharmacy on the candidates in the following words:

"MR. VICE-CHANCELLOR SIR,

I beg to move that a grace of the Executive Council be passed that the persons whose names are herewith appended and whom the Executive Council on the report of the examiners duly appointed, have certified to be qualified severally for the respective degrees, diplomas and medals and detailed in the list appended, be admitted to the respective degrees, diplomas and medals."

Prof. D. Chennappa, Dean, Faculty of Commerce and Business Management will second thE supplication.

I SECOND THE SUPPLICATION

The Vice-Chancellor will put the following question to the Members of the Executive Council:

"DOTH IT PLEASE YOU THAT THIS GRACE BE PASSED?"

The Members of the Executive Council shall reply:

"YES, THE GRACE BE PASSED."

The Vice-Chancellor shall then declare:

"THE GRACE IS PASSED."

After this the Members of the Executive Council and Deans shall disperse and join the procession that will be formed after the group photo.

ARRIVAL OF THE CHIEF GUEST

The Chief Guest will arrive at 2.55 PM and will be received by the Vice-Chancellor and the Registrar and will be led to the Dressing Room for wearing the robe and badge.

ARRIVAL OF THE CHANCELLOR

The Chancellor will arrive at 3.00 PM and will be received by the Vice-Chancellor and the Registrar and will be led to the Dressing Room for wearing the robe and badge.

GROUP PHOTO

The Vice-Chancellor will request **the Chancellor**, and the Chief Guest to join for the group photo along with the Members of the Executive Council, the Deans of the Faculties and Registrar at 3.05 PM.

ACADEMIC PROCESSION

After the group photo, the Procession with the Registrar in the front will be formed comprising Deans, of Faculties, Members of the Executive Council, the Vice-Chancellor, the Chief Guest, and the Chancellor and walk to the dais.

On the approach of the procession, the candidates and the guests shall rise and remain standing until the procession reaches the dais, and dignitaries have taken their respective seats.

COMMENCEMENT OF CONVOCATION

The Vice-Chancellor shall ask the Chancellor

"Do I have the permission of the Chancellor to commence the Convocation Proceedings?"

The Chancellor will say "Yes", permitted.

The Vice-Chancellor declares the Convocation open by saying,

"I declare the Convocation open"

"This Convocation of Palamuru University has been called to confer the Degrees, Diplomas upon the candidates who have been certified to be worthy of them by the Executive Council."

ADMINISTERING OATH / PROMISES

Registrar: "Will all the candidates for the award of Degrees and Diplomas stand and answer the three questions put to them by the Vice-Chancellor with the words: "I do promise" after each question.

The Vice-Chancellor will ask

Question: "Do you solemnly and sincerely promise and declare that if admitted to the Degree for which you have been qualified, you will, in your daily life and conversation, conduct yourself as become worthy Members of this University?"

The candidates answer: "I do promise".

The Vice-Chancellor will ask

Question: "Do you solemnly and sincere/y promise and declare that to the utmost of your opportunity and ability, you will use your power for the promotion of true learning in the service of your fellowmen?"

The candidates answer: "I do Promise".

The Vice-Chancellor will ask

Question: "Do you solemnly and sincerely promise that you will faithfully and diligently fulfill the duties of the profession to which you will eventually belong and that you will, on all occasions, maintain its purity and reputation?"

The candidates answer: "I do promise".

The candidates shall then resume their seats.

PRESENTATION OF CANDIDATES FOR Ph.D. DEGREE.

The Vice-Chancellor shall say:

"Let the candidates be presented".

Prof. T. Krishna Rao, Dean, Faculty of Arts & Social Sciences, will address the candidates thus:

"Will the candidates for the Degrees of Doctor of Philosophy in the Faculties of Arts and Social Sciences and Science Kindly stand?

He shall present the candidates and say:

"Mr. Vice-Chancellor, I present to you these candidates and pray that they may be admitted to the Degrees of Doctor of Philosophy in the Faculties of Arts & Social Sciences and Science for which they have qualified"

The Vice-Chancellor shall then say to the 'candidates, who shall remain standing: '

"By virtue of the authority vested in me as the Vice-Chancellor of Palamuru University, 'I admit you to the Degrees of Doctor of Philosophy in the Faculty Arts & Social Sciences and Science for which you have qualified, and I charge you throughout your life to prove worthy of this Degree."

Prof. T. Krishna Rao, Dean, Faculty of Arts & Social Sciences, will announce "the Ph.D. candidates may please come to the dais and receive the degrees from the Chancellor in the order being announced".

The Vice-Chancellor shall say:

"I request the Hon'ble Chancellor to please present the Ph.D. Degrees to the candidates".

The Candidates, after receiving their degrees shall resume their seats.

SIGNING OF THE REGISTER BY THE CHANCELLOR

When all the candidates have been presented, the Registrar shall place, the Record of the Degrees, and Diplomas that have been conferred before **the Chancellor**, who shall then affix his signature thereto.

AWARD OF GOLD MEDALS

The Registrar will say "Madam Chancellor, I pray that the Gold Medals be awarded to the candidates who have been declared entitled to receive the Gold Medals ".

The Registrar will read out the names of the candidates who have been declared entitled to receive Gold Medals at the University Examinations and as she reads out each name, the candidate shall come to the dais and receive the Gold Medal from the Chancellor.

VICE-CHANCELLOR'S REPORT

The Vice-Chancellor will present his Report reviewing the work and activities of the University and then request the Chief Guest to address the Convocation.

CHIEF GUEST'S ADDRESS

The Chief Guest will deliver the Convocation Address.

CHANCELLOR'S MESSAGE

The Vice-Chancellor will say "May I request, Madam Chancellor Dr. Smt. Tamilisai Soundararajan garu, to give her Message".

The Chancellor will give her message.

PRESENTATION OF MEMENTOES

The Vice-Chancellor, will present memento to the Hon'ble Chancellor and Chief Guest.

DISSOLUTION OF THE CONVOCATION

The Vice-Chancellor will say to the Chancellor

"Do I have the permission of Madam Chancellor to dissolve the Convocation?"

The Chancellor shall say

"Yes, permitted".

The Vice-Chancellor will say: I declare the convocation dissolved.

THE NATIONAL ANTHEM

The National Anthem will then be played. All shall stand.

RETREAT

The Chancellor, the Chief Guest, the Vice-Chancellor, the Members of the Executive Council, the Deans of the Faculties and the Registrar shall then retire in a procession, while the candidates and guests remain standing.

The Guests and candidates shall remain standing at their seats till the entire procession has left the Hall.
